

COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols for Paradise Ice Skating Public and Figure Sessions

PURPOSE

The COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols for Paradise Ice Skating outlined to be implemented at 136 Lansford Crescent & 490 Ti Rakau Drive to manage risk of COVID-19 transmission on site. These Protocols apply at Alert Level 2 & 1.

OUR COMMITMENT:

- We are committed to working alongside Government to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- As a company, we are united against COVID-19 and will do our utmost to protect our workers, the wider community, and New Zealand.
- We are all in this together trusting those we work with will keep us safe as we will do for them.
- We recognise that we must work together to ensure the health, safety, and wellbeing of everyone in the company and community.

All alert level information is kept up to date based on the New Zealand Government website.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE ON SITE

- Arrival on site not more than 10 minutes prior to session time and leave facility within 10 minutes of session end time.
- Use hand sanitizer at point of entry and exit of facility.
- Each site will have a sign-in register at the entry point in the foyer that includes name, full contact details and time in, and also sign out when exiting.

As per the New Zealand Government alert level two guidelines:

People at high risk of severe illness (older people and those with existing medical conditions) are encouraged to stay at home where possible, and take additional precautions when leaving home.

LEVEL 2 REGULATIONS

- 1) Stay away from the rink if you are sick or display any signs of illness.
- 2) Skates to be put on in the grandstand with minimum 1m distancing. No use of café for skate lacing or chatting.
- 3) Skaters and coaches to maintain minimum 1m distancing.
- 4) Maximum 100 people in the building and groups are limited to 10 people. Parents encouraged to wait outside where possible. If in the rink, parents/caregivers must maintain 1m distancing and watch either from the café or from the grandstand.
- 5) You must follow MOH regulations regarding COVID-19 and isolation requirements.
- 6) Sanitizer and soap are provided around the rink for public and staff use.
- 7) Cough/sneeze into bent elbow or tissue and immediately dispose of used tissues.
- 8) If you display any signs of illness, you will be asked to leave.
- 9) Please report any identified hazards or concerns to your coach or the Paradise duty manager.
- 10) All people onsite have an obligation to inform the site owner Chris Blong if they become unwell or become aware they have had contact with a suspected COVID-19 case.

LEVEL 1 REGULATIONS

- 1) No restrictions on gatherings.
- 2) Stay home if you are sick or display any signs of illness.
- 3) Physical distancing is encouraged.
- 4) Cough into elbow/ tissue. Dispose of tissues immediately. Wash and dry hands. Do not touch your face.
- 5) You must follow MOH regulations regarding COVID-19 and isolation requirements.

Each skater will need to provide their own fluro armband to be worn during private lessons. If you are unable to make your own they will be available to purchase at an estimated cost of \$5. Skaters are to wear the fluro armband on the pink side when in a lesson and on the green/yellow side when their program music is being played.
